Home Sustainability Assessment Scheme

Home Sustainability Assessors need to be certified under the Home Sustainability Assessment Scheme (HSAS) to conduct assessments as part of the Australian Government Green Loans Program.

The Australian Government has sponsored the development of a short course for Home Sustainability Assessors. The course prepares people to conduct Home Sustainability Assessments and to ensure that they are suitably qualified and experienced. Once you have completed the HAS training, you can apply to HSAS to become certified to conduct assessments under the Australian Government Green Loans Program or apply your skills and knowledge to work within the environmental industry or support numerous local state government programs.

The HSAS short course typically takes four days of classroom training to complete, although recognition of prior learning is available from course providers. Training providers may require pre-requisite qualifications and/or experience prior to enrolling candidates.

Examples of pre-requisite qualifications or experience may include:

- *Building Thermal Performance Assessment (Residential);* or
- A qualification in Architecture or Building Design; or
- Substantial experience in the building industry; or
- Home Sustainability Assessment registration 21854-VIC
