The following unit – CPCPCM 4001A Carry out work-based risk control processes – is a pre-requisite for the Backflow Prevention course. You must complete this unit before the Backflow course.

Purpose:

This unit of competence specifies the outcomes required to understand the minimum requirements of Backflow Prevention, as required by the Water Authority of Western Australia.

An understanding of the various mechanical devices, their specific uses, and testing requirements.

To provide the specific requirements for the installation of break tanks (water storage tanks) which include, air gap requirements, spill level requirements and overflow requirements.

Certification:

Upon successfully completing this course students will receive certificate in Backflow Prevention and will be issued with a Backflow Permit Number. This number will be lodged with the Water Corporation.

30 hours of training
