



CPCPGS4002A SERVICE TYPE A GAS APPLIANCES COURSE OUTLINE

Purpose:

This unit of competence meets Energy Safety requirements in Western Australia and is an Australian National Training Authority unit of competence.

This unit of competence specifies the outcomes required to diagnose and repair faults on domestic and commercial Type A gas appliances. Work associated with this unit is undertaken within the scope of AS5601 (AG601) gas installations and local licensing requirements (gas, electrical and plumbing).

Entry requirements:

Candidates will require a Certificate III in Plumbing or equivalent qualification and a restricted Class G Gasfitting Permit from the Office of Energy Safety to enroll in this course.

Course content will include:

- Electrical safety and isolation
- Gas controls
- Safety devices
- Thermostats
- Appliance conversions
- Appliance servicing.

Successful Completion:

Successful Completion of this unit will enable candidates to perform installation and servicing work associated with a Class G Gasfitting Permit from the Office of Energy Safety.

Certification:

Candidates will be awarded a Statement of Attainment.

Duration:

174 hours of training conducted over a period of approximately 3 months

Maximum Participants:

15 persons.

Training Course: \$2,180.00 per person including text books being AS3500, Gas Standards Regulations 1999, Gas Installations Cod, Water Services Regulations.????
