



## **CPCPCM4001A CARRY OUT WORK BASED RISK CONTROL PROCESSES COURSE OUTLINE**

### **Purpose:**

This unit of competence specifies the outcomes required to carry out work based risk control processes. It covers the identification of hazards, the assessment of risk, the identification of unacceptable risk and the determination, preparation and completion of a course of action.

This unit is to be applied by employees with the responsibility for the safety of others, including work activity co-ordinators, plant operators or equivalent who co-ordinate workplace activities, team leaders, supervisors and managers.

### **Entry requirements:**

Candidates will require a Trade Certificate at Certificate III level to enroll in this course.

### **Certification:**

Candidates will be awarded a Statement of Attainment.

### **Duration:**

40 hours of training
