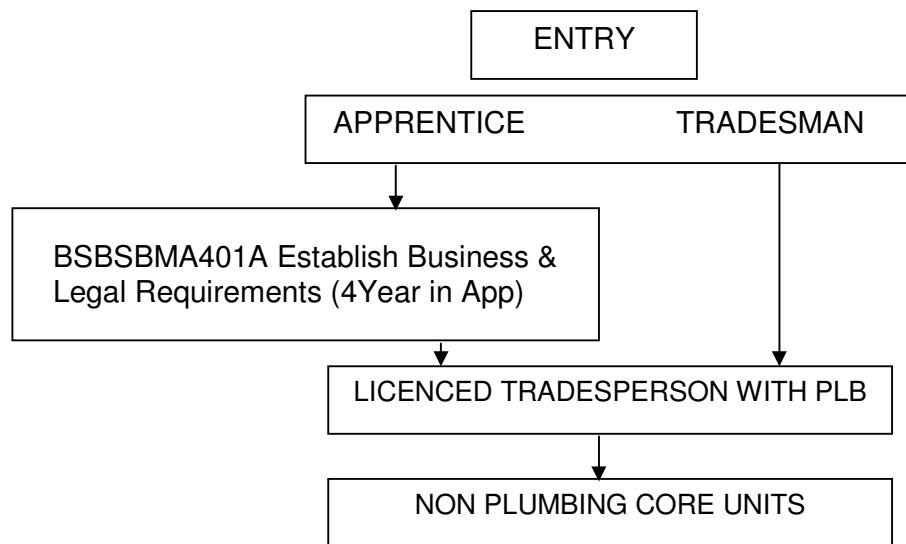


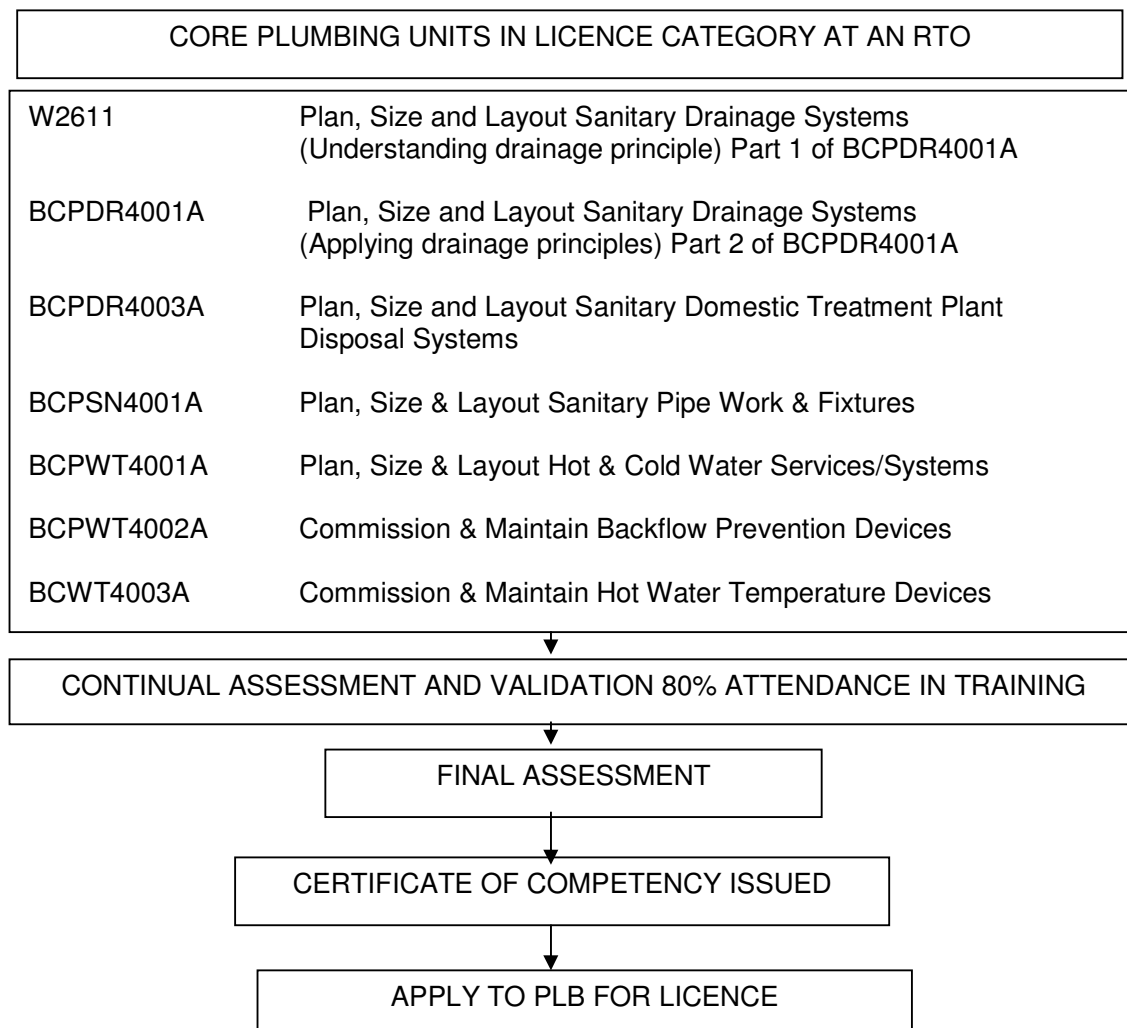

## **MPA SKILLS**

### **Training and Assessment Process For Plumbing Contractor's Licence**

**Attached** is the training process (flow chart) for individuals accessing training and assessment at MPA Skills in relation to the Plumbing Contractor's Licence.

#### **Role of MPA Skills':**

MPA Skills is the Registered Training Organisation and will:

- a) provide you with the relevant training;
- b) the assessment and validation of competency.

Upon successful completion of the unit of competency MPA Skills will provide you with a Statement of Results.

#### **Role of Plumbers Licensing Board:**

The Plumbing Licensing Board of WA ("PLB") is the licensing authority

Participants who have successfully completed units of competency and are deemed competent will be issued with a Statement of Results which should be presented by the participant to the PLB as part of their application process.

#### **Assessment:**

There will be ongoing assessment throughout the course of training in each unit. There is also a final assessment. The following Flow Chart defines the assessment process:

# MPA SKILLS ASSESSMENT FLOW CHART FOR PLUMBING CONTRACTOR'S LICENCE



A) COMMENCE UNIT OF TRAINING

NOTE: The business units must be successfully completed prior to enrolment in any of the technical units. Proof of completion must be provided

B) ONGOING ASSESSMENT AND VALIDATION OF COMPETENCY

NOTE: All must be completed prior to sitting the final assessment

TRAINING

Further training may be accessed at a fee for service cost if and as required.

MPA Skills will notify participant of the areas defined as "Not Yet Competent".

Participants may require further training or participants can attempt to resit assessment without further training. It is their choice.

Referred to Training Manager for interview to discuss further training assessment requirements.

Within 14 working days of sitting the Final Assessment for a particular Unit of Competency, participants will receive a Statement of Results in the post. The participant should present the Statement of Results to the PLB as part of their application process.
