

# Restricted Gas Assessment

## About this Course

This course meets Energy Safety requirements in Western Australia. This unit of competence specifies the outcomes required to diagnose and repair faults on domestic and commercial Type A gas appliances. Work associated with this unit is undertaken within the scope of AS5601:2013 gas installations and local licensing requirements (gas, electrical and plumbing)

## Pre Requisites

- Must be a qualified plumber
- Must have a USI Number ([www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au))

## There are 3 categories

1. **within 2 years** – a permit can be issued by Energy Safety on receipt of the application. You will not need to attend the Restricted Gas Assessment
2. **between 2 and 5 years** – the person is required to complete successfully a theory assessment on the Gas Standards Legislation and the AS/NZS 5601 Gas Installation
3. **more than 5 years/ new applicant** – the person is required to complete successfully a theory and practical assessment on the Gas Standards Legislation and theory and practical assessment through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or undertake training for the Certificate III in Gasfitting. MPA Skills deliver the Certificate III in Gasfitting, please see our website for course dates
