- Safety equipment and clothing
- Work experience
- Regular mentoring by industry personnel
- Specialist workshops about building and construction
- Advice about career pathways
- Meetings with industry employers
- Regular reports to parents and schools

WA students entering Year 11 next year who are keen on a career in a career in the building and construction industry.



APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1 Fill out the application online before the end of September. Your application must be endorsed by a teacher, school representative and a primary caregiver.
- 2 Your application will be reviewed by an industry panel for short-listing.
- 3 If you are shortlisted, you'll be invited to attend an industry panel interview, together with your parents.
- 4 Confirmation of your participation in the program, by mid November.
